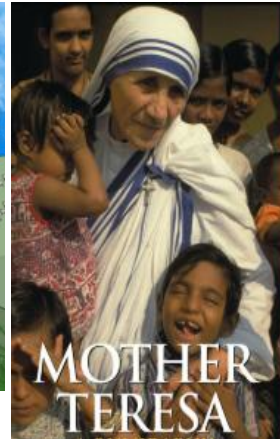
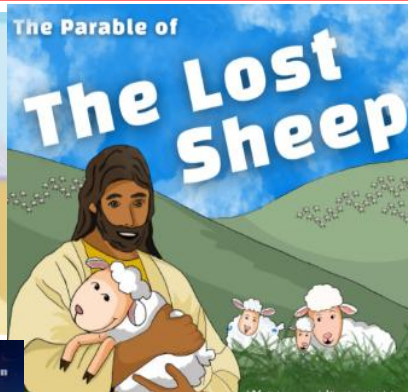
Links to Prior knowledge:
