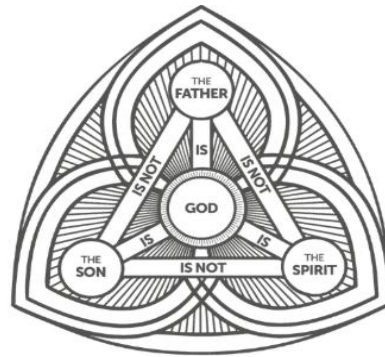
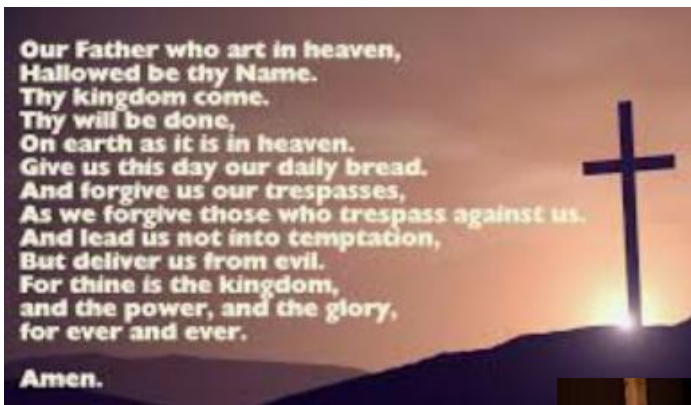

Key Vocabulary

Christian	Believes in Jesus Christ and God.
spiritual	Relating to the human spirit or soul as opposed to material or physical things.
celebration	A joyful occasion to mark some happy event.
incarnation	God taking on a human body and becoming a man.
resurrection	The concept of coming back to life after death.
Christmas	Celebrates the birth of Jesus Christ.
Easter	Celebrates Jesus rising from the dead.
Lord's Prayer	The prayer taught by Jesus to his disciples.
Holy Trinity	God exists as one God in three distinct persons: Father, Son (Jesus) and Holy Spirit.
