- To know that the Bible teaches us about Jesus.

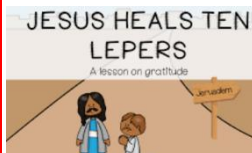
Key Skill

Parables

Parables were stories that Jesus told with a meaning. Jesus was an amazing storyteller and these stories were linked to the everyday lives of his listeners. These stories (parables) were about the Kingdom of God; they showed people how to behave, how to treat others and how to pray.

Key Vocabulary

Christian	Believes in Jesus Christ and God.
Bible	The holy book of the Christian religion
compassion	Think about how someone else is feeling; put yourself in their shoes.
endurance	To keep going, even when things are hard.
forgiveness	To let go of anger towards someone.
hope	Positive feeling or belief.
thankfulness	Being content and saying thank you for what you have.
peace	Living well together; being free; quiet and calm.
miracle	An event that is really special and amazing, like something beyond what we normally expect or can easily
