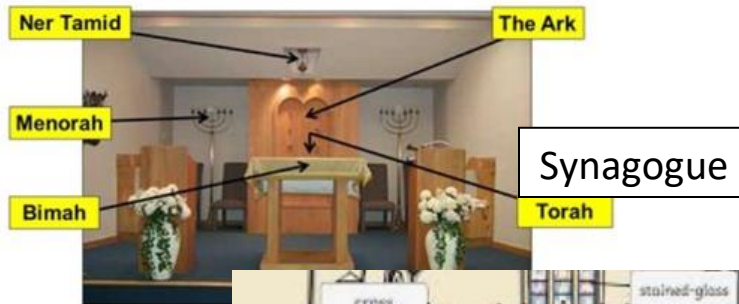
Key Vocabulary

synagogue	A Jewish place of Worship

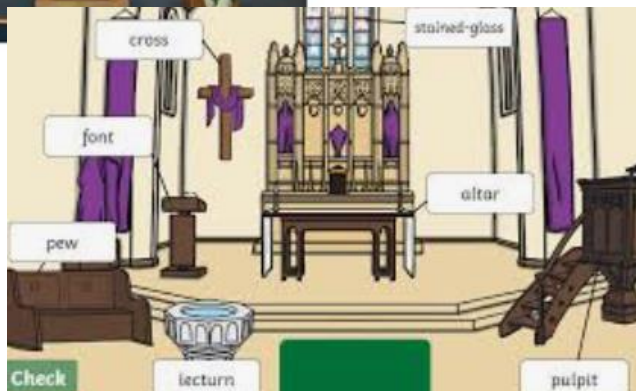
