



Unit 2.1 What makes some people inspiring to others? Moses and Saint Peter

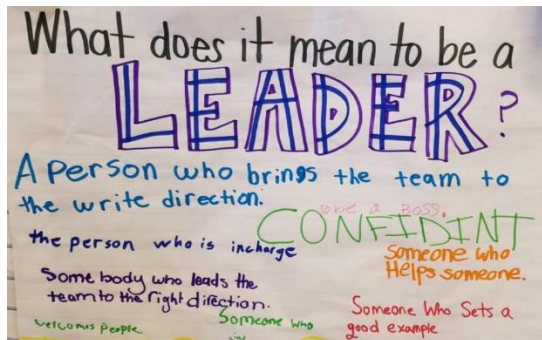

Role Models	A person looked to by others as an example to be imitated.
