Science is the study of the natural and man-made world through questioning, observation and experimentation.

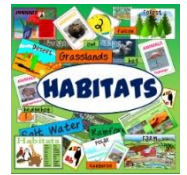

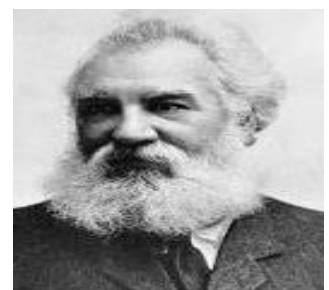

What is a scientist?

A scientist tries to understand how our world, or other things, work. Scientists make observations, ask questions and find the answers to many questions others may not know about. Scientists are people who discover new things and research how things work.



Alexander Graham Bell (1847-1922) is credited with being the inventor of the telephone. In 1876, at the age of 29, he invented the telephone.
