Sprunki warning

We have been made aware of a game named Sprunki. While it appears to be a cute music-making game, it often features hidden "horror" modes that include intense gore, creepy imagery, and disturbing themes. Whilst it does not have an official age rating, user reviews, safety guides and parental reports strongly suggest it is not suitable for young children. A safe and similar music-making game without the horror elements is available called Incredibox. We advise you to check the game content if you are aware your child plays the game.

A message from the Local Authority

It will help to build a clear and honest picture of what is working well, where there are gaps, and what needs to change.

They will review all responses and use them to shape the priorities and actions within the plan, including the improvement and transformation work taken forward as a partnership.

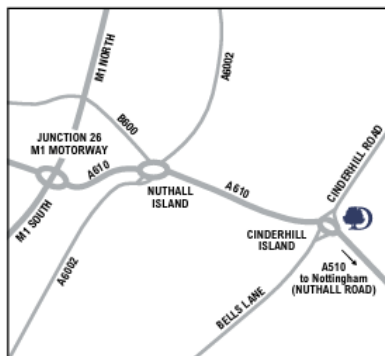
