We have been sent a photograph today of a car parked illegally on double yellow lines which has been shared with the police by residents. School will support the police in any action they choose to take to ensure the safety of pupils, residents and other parents around our school. The police have advised they will be patrolling the area around drop-off and collection times.

We understand that these times can be busy, but we kindly ask everyone to be mindful of residents, other road users and, most importantly, the safety of our children. Please ensure that you park legally and safely and drive slowly and carefully when approaching and leaving the school. Thank you for your cooperation and support in helping us to keep our school community safe.

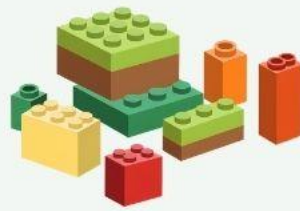
