Therapy dogs in school



We are delighted to announce we are welcoming two dogs, Paddy and Reubus and their trained handler, Katherine Mucha, to our school on Thursday 4th June. She will be spending some time in school every Thursday morning in two secure spaces working with some pupils.

Uncle Paddy and Nephew Reubus are family-related working Cocker Spaniels known for their friendly, loyal, and sociable nature. Their greatest value lies in their affectionate and comforting presence. Paddy, aged 5, and Reubus, approaching 2, have been with Katherine since they were young

puppies and have always been around young children. Both dogs are insured as therapy dogs, regularly supporting wellbeing initiatives through their calm and gentle temperaments.



Paddy and Reubus will have constant supervision by their handler, Katherine. No child will be left alone with the dogs and a school risk assessment to allow them to work in the building is in place. The dogs will be kept on leads when they need to move outdoors.

Children and staff who have allergies to dogs

Parents and carers need to advise the school if their child has an allergy to dogs. Paddy and Reubus will not be allowed in parts of the school where children have allergies. Good hygiene routines and hand washing is to be followed by all who meet and work with the dogs. Should any child develop allergic symptoms whilst working or following working with Paddy and Reubus, parents and carers will be informed immediately.

Children who have a fear of dogs

Please inform your child's class teacher if your child has a fear or phobia of dogs. As a school, we will ensure to minimise any risk of your child coming into direct contact with Paddy and Reubus. They will be working in two designated private spaces in school, so unplanned contact is extremely unlikely.

Health and Well-being of the dogs

The dogs are vaccinated, wormed and flea protected in accordance with the vet's recommendation. If the dogs are unwell, they will not visit the school. They are walked before attending school and will have regular breaks built into their morning, where they can rest peacefully.
