Staffing update

Today your child will have come home with a slip to let you know their new teacher for next year if they are moving class. Some of you may have noticed that only Miss Giles name is on the slips for those of you in Orange Class. I am pleased to confirm that this is because Miss Giles will be returning to teach full time from September now her son is older.

Unfortunately, this means that Miss Heaton will be leaving us at the end of this year. I would like to thank Miss Heaton for her years at Edgewood nurturing and supporting so many pupils and all her work as part of the KS1 team and covering maternity leave. I hope you will all wish her all the best for the future.

Hot weather

With the weather looking to turn warmer again next week we have been reviewing what happened during the previous week. While the forecast is currently not as extreme as it was in June, can I please remind all parents to follow the advice from the Department for Education to ensure that your child is wearing loose, thin clothing, a hat, they bring a water bottle to school that can be regularly refilled and you ensure they are wearing highly effective all day sun cream (ideally factor 50 plus) or are bringing their own suncream into school to apply it themselves (staff will supervise younger children in doing this).

Unless the DfE guidance changes, schools are expected to stay open to all pupils. In fact the Department for Education has been writing to schools that did close demanding to know why they closed when the guidance was to stay open, even in Red Alert areas!

However, we found last week that once the temperature exceeded 32oC in our building the conditions were too hot to effectively house all pupils. So, should the temperature outside achieve that setting again we will be sending a message out to ask you to collect your children if you are able to. School will not close if you aren't able to collect your children at this point.

If we end up in a Red Alert zone, this might change but that is not currently forecast for the rest of this academic year.

Thank you to all of you who supported us with staying open in such difficult circumstances last week - we know that if we close it causes massive difficulties for all of you, especially around your work, and we will always try to avoid that unless we have no other option.
